BEER EXCISE.

No. 38 of 1928.

An Act to amend the Beer Excise Act 1901-1923

[Assented to 25th September, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :----

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Beer Excise Act 1928.

(2.) The Beer Excise Act 1901-1923* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Beer Excise Act 1901-1928.

2. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the Definitions. definition of "Quarts, pints or half-pints" and inserting in its stead the following definition :---

"' Quarts, pints, half-pints or quarter-pints' means quart, pint, half-pint or quarter-pint bottles, and includes bottles reputed to contain quarts, pints, half-pints or quarter-pints.".

3. Section forty-four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting size of vessels. the words "or half-pints" and inserting in their stead the words "half-pints or quarter-pints".
