An Act to amend section one hundred and twelve of the Customs Act 1901-1910.

[Assented to 7th December, 1914.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:--

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Act 1914. (2.) The Customs Act 1901-1910, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Act 1901-1914.

- 2. Section one hundred and twelve of the Customs Act 1901-1910 Amendment of is amended—

 - (a) by inserting after sub-section (1.) the following subsection :-
 - "(1A.) In time of war the Governor-General may by proclamation prohibit the exportation of any goods."; and
 - (b) by inserting in sub-section (2.), after the words "subsection (1.)", the words "or (1A.)"; and
 - (c) by inserting the words "and sub-section (1A.)" after the words "paragraph (b)".
