

CUSTOMS.

No. 19 of 1914.

An Act to amend section one hundred and twelve
of the *Customs Act* 1901-1910.

[Assented to 7th December, 1914.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Customs Act* 1914.

Short title and
citation.

(2.) The *Customs Act* 1901-1910, as amended by this Act, may
be cited as the *Customs Act* 1901-1914.

2. Section one hundred and twelve of the *Customs Act* 1901-1910
is amended—

Amendment of
s. 112.

(a) by inserting after sub-section (1.) the following sub-
section:—

“(1A.) In time of war the Governor-General may
by proclamation prohibit the exportation of
any goods.”; and

(b) by inserting in sub-section (2.), after the words “sub-
section (1.)”, the words “or (1A.)”; and

(c) by inserting the words “and sub-section (1A.)” after the
words “paragraph (b)”.
