

(2.) The *Representation Act 1948**, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Representation Act 1948-1949*.

2. Section seven of the *Representation Act 1948* is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead :—

“7. The allowance payable under the *Parliamentary Allowances Act 1920-1947* to a senator to whom sub-section (3.) or (4.) of section five of this Act applies shall be reckoned from and including the day of his election.”

An Act to amend the *Customs Act 1901-1947*.

[Assented to 27th October, 1949.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Customs Act 1949*.

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Customs Act 1901-1947**, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Customs Act 1901-1949*.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation.

Commencement.

3.—(1.) After section one hundred and sixty-four of the *Customs Act 1901-1947* the following section is inserted :—

“164A. A rebate, as prescribed, may be made of duty payable on the importation of leaf tobacco, as an allowance in respect of waste in manufacturing operations.”

Rebate of duty on leaf tobacco on account of waste.

(2.) The section inserted in the *Customs Act 1901-1947* by this section shall not apply in relation to leaf tobacco entered for home consumption before the commencement of this Act.
