

CONSTITUTION ALTERATION (STATE DEBTS).

No. 3 of 1910.

An Act to alter the provisions of the Constitution relating to the Public Debts of the States.

[Assented to 6th August, 1910.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the approval of the electors, as required by the Constitution, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as *Constitution Alteration (State Debts) 1909.* Short title.

2. Section one hundred and five of the Constitution is altered by omitting the words "as existing at the establishment of the Commonwealth." Alteration of s. 105.

OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 4 of 1910.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 9th August, 1910.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Old-age Pensions Appropriation Act 1910.* Short title.
