

COMMONWEALTH EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION.

No. 94 of 1962.

An Act to amend section four A of the *Commonwealth Employees' Compensation Act 1930-1959* in consequence of the enactment of the *Repatriation (Special Overseas Service) Act 1962*.

[Assented to 14th December, 1962.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Commonwealth Employees' Compensation Act 1962*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Commonwealth Employees' Compensation Act 1930-1959*,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Commonwealth Employees' Compensation Act 1930-1962*.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which the *Repatriation (Special Overseas Service) Act 1962* comes into operation. Commencement.

3. Section four A of the *Commonwealth Employees' Compensation Act 1930-1959* is amended by omitting from sub-section (6A.) the words "*Repatriation (Far East Strategic Reserve) Act 1956*" and inserting in their stead the words "*Repatriation (Far East Strategic Reserve) Act 1956-1962* or the *Repatriation (Special Overseas Service) Act 1962*". Application of Act.
