## COLONIAL LIGHT DUES COLLEOTION.

## No. 15 of 1934.

An Act to amend the Colonial Light Dues Collection Act 1932.
[Assented to 30th July, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the Honse of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-
1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Colonial Light Dues Short titleand Collection Act 1934.
(2.) The Colonial Light Dues Collestion Act 1932* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Colonial Light Dues Collection Act 1932-1934.
2. Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting sub-sections (2.) and (3.).
3. After section for of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:-
" 4 A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, exemptions from Colonial light dues, or remissions of the whole or part thereof, may be grantel by he Collector of Customs for a State in circumstances similar to those under which the Board of Trade of the United Kingdom grant ezemptions or remissions of light dues payable in the United Kingdom.".
4. Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by adding at nogulationa, the end thereof the words ", and in particular for defining the ships which shall be deemed to have passed and to have derived benefit from a lighthouse or buoy specified in the Schedule.".
