

CATTLE SLAUGHTER LEVY REPEAL.

No. 11 of 1964.

An Act to repeal the *Cattle Slaughter Levy Act 1960*,
and for purposes connected therewith.

[Assented to 6th May, 1964.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Cattle Slaughter Levy Repeal Act 1964*. Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the date fixed by Proclamation under section two of the *Live-stock Slaughter Levy Act 1964*. Commencement.

3.—(1.) Subject to the next succeeding sub-section, the *Cattle Slaughter Levy Act 1960* is repealed. Repeal and savings.

(2.) Subject to the *Cattle Slaughter Levy (Suspension) Act 1961*, the provisions of the *Cattle Slaughter Levy Act 1960*, and the regulations under that last-mentioned Act in force immediately before the date of the commencement of this Act, continue to apply in relation to cattle slaughtered for human consumption on and after the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty and before the date of the commencement of this Act.
