## An Act relating to Duties of Customs.

[Assented to 15th May, 1964-]
$\mathbf{B}^{\mathrm{E}}$ it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-
1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff 1964.

Short title and citation.
(2.) The Customs Tariff 1933-1963* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff 1933-1964.
2. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
3.-(1.) The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended as set out in the First Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are imposed in accordance with the Schedule to the Principal Act as so amended.
