An Act relating to Duties of Customs.

[Assented to 23rd May, 1962.]

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (No. 3) Short title 1962.

and citation.

- (2.) The Customs Tariff 1933-1961,* as amended by the Customs Tariff (No. 2) 1962,† is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) Section one of the Customs Tariff (No. 2) 1962 is amended by omitting sub-section (4.).
- (4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act and by the Customs Tariff 1962,‡ may be cited as the Customs Tariff 1933-1962.
- 2. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this Act shall commences come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal ment. Assent.

3.—(1.) The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended as set Amendment out in the First Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are of Tariff in accordance imposed in accordance with the Schedule to the Principal Act with First as so amended. (2.) This

- (2.) This section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the eleventh day of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.

Amendment of Tariff in accordance with Third Schedule.

- 5.—(1.) The Schedule to the Principal Act as amended by the last two preceding sections is further amended as set out in the Third Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are imposed in accordance with the Schedule to the Principal Act as so amended and as so further amended.
- (2.) This section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirteenth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.
