Customs Tariff (No. 5)

No. 70 of 1967

An Act relating to Duties of Customs.

[Assented to 31 October 1967]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (No. 5) 1967.
- (2.) The Customs Tariffs 1966,* as amended by the Customs Tariff 1967,† by the Customs Tariff (No. 2) 1967,‡ by the Customs Tariff (No. 3) 1967\sqrt{s} and by the Customs Tariff (No. 4) 1967,\frac{n}{2} is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) Section 1 of the Customs Tariff (No. 4) 1967 is amended by omitting sub-section (4.).
- (4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff 1966–1967.

Commence-

- 2.—(1.) Subject to this section, this Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- (2.) Section 3 of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the third day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven.
- (3.) Section 4 of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the fourteenth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixtyseven.
- (4.) Section 5 of this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the eighteenth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixtyseven.
