No. 8 of 1948.

An Act to repeal certain Acts relating to Adjustments in Duties of Customs.

[Assented to 27th April, 1948.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Exchange Adjust-short title ment) Act Repeal Act 1948.
 - 2. The Acts specified in the Schedule to this Act are repealed. Repeal.
- 3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the Time of fifteenth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and forty-operation. seven, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Australian Capital Territory.

An Act relating to Duties of Customs.

[Assented to 27th April, 1948.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (No. 3) 1948.
- (2.) The Customs Tariff 1933-1939*, as amended by the Customs Tariff 1948† and by the Customs Tariff (No. 2) 1948‡, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) Section one of the Customs Tariff (No. 2) 1948 is amended by omitting sub-section (4.).
- (4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff 1933-1948.

Amendment of Tariff.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are hereby imposed in accordance with the first-mentioned Schedule as amended by the last-mentioned Schedule.
