An Act to amend the Customs Tariff (Papua and New Guinea Preference) 1936-1956.

[Assented to 25th November, 1957.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Papua short title and citation. and New Guinea Preference) 1957.

- (2.) The Customs Tariff (Papua and New Guinea Preference) 1936-1956,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Papua and New Guinea Preference) 1936-1957.
- 2. The Schedule to the Customs Tariff (Papua and New Amendment of Tariff. Guinea Preference) 1936-1956 is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are imposed in accordance with the first-mentioned Schedule as amended by the last-mentioned Schedule.

3. The time of the imposition of the duties of Customs Time of imposed by this Act is the eighteenth day of October, One imposition of duties, thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven, at nine o'clock in the
