## CUSTOMS TARIFF (CANADIAN PREFERENCE).

### No. 5 of 1954.

# An Act to amend the Customs Tariff (Canadian Preference) 1934-1952.

### [Assented to 20th April, 1954.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

**1**.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Canadian Preference) 1954.

(2.) The Customs Tariff (Canadian Preference) 1934–1952,\* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Canadian Preference) 1934–1954.

2. The Schedule to the Customs Tariff (Canadian Preference) 1934–1952 is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are imposed in accordance with the first-mentioned Schedule as amended by the last-mentioned Schedule.

**3.** The time of the imposition of the duties of Customs imposed by this Act is the sixteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-four, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Australian Capital Territory, and this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation at that time.
