CUSTOMS TARIFF VALIDATION.

No. 17 of 1919.

An Act to provide for the Validation of Collections of Duties of Customs under Tariff Proposals.

[Assented to 28th October, 1919,]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff Validation Act short title. 1919.
- 2. In this Act "Tariff proposals" means the proposed Duties of Definition. Customs introduced into the House of Representatives on the following dates, namely:-

10th August, 1917; 26th September, 1917; 25th September, 1918;

25th September, 1918.

- (Relating to the Tariff on goods imported from and the produce or manufacture of the Union of South Africa.)
- 3. All Duties of Customs demanded or collected (whether before Validation of or after the termination of the present House of Representatives) under Tariff pursuant to the Tariff proposals to which this Act applies shall be proposals. deemed to have been lawfully imposed and lawfully demanded or collected.
