

## INVALID AND OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

### No. 50 of 1936.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 12th October, 1936.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Appropriation Act 1936*.

Short title.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act 1901-1934*, and known as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Twelve million pounds for invalid and old-age pensions.

Appropriation of £12,000,000 for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

## CUSTOMS TARIFF VALIDATION.

### No. 51 of 1936.

An Act to provide for the Validation of Collections of Duties of Customs under Customs Tariff Proposals.

[Assented to 19th November, 1936.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Customs Tariff Validation Act 1936*.

Short title.

2. All duties of Customs demanded or collected, on or before the seventh day of December, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, pursuant to the Customs Tariff proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the twenty-second day of May, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, shall be deemed to have been lawfully imposed and lawfully demanded or collected.
