

CUSTOMS TARIFF VALIDATION.

No. 28 of 1952.

An Act to provide for the Validation of Collections of Duties of Customs under Customs Tariff Proposals.

[Assented to 6th November, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Customs Tariff Validation Act* 1952. Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent. Commencement.

3. All duties of Customs demanded or collected (whether before or after the commencement of this Act and on or before the twenty-fifth day of September, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two) pursuant to Customs Tariff Proposals No. 5 introduced into the House of Representatives on the twenty-ninth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, shall be deemed to have been lawfully imposed and lawfully demanded or collected.
