CUSTOMS TARIFF VALIDATION.

No. 25 of 1952.

An Act to provide for the Validation Collections of Duties of Customs under Customs Tariff Proposals.

[Assented to 6th November, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff Validation Act short title. 1952.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement. receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. All duties of Customs demanded or collected (whether before validation of collections under Customs under Customs under Customs fifth day of September, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two) Tariff Proposals. pursuant to Customs Tariff Proposals No. 5 introduced into the House of Representatives on the twenty-ninth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, shall be deemed to have been awfully imposed and lawfully demanded or collected.
