CUSTOMS TARIFF (NEW ZEALAND PREFERENCE).

No. 23 of 1950.

An Act to amend the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1949.

[Assented to 11th November, 1950.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1 .- (1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Short title Preference) 1950.

- (2.) The Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1949*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933–1950.
- 2. The Schedule to the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) Amendment of Tariff. 1933-1949 is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are hereby imposed in accordance with the firstmentioned Schedule as amended by the last-mentioned Schedule.

3. The time for the imposition of the duties of Customs imposed Time for by this Act is the twelfth day of May, One thousand nine hundred of duties. and fifty, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Australian Capital Territory, and this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation at that time.
