CUSTOMS TARIFF (NEW ZEALAND PREFERENCE).

An Act to amend the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference). 1933-1950.

[Assented to 6th November, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1952.
- (2.) The Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1950*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1952.

Amendment of Tariff.

2. The Schedule to the Customs Tariff (New Zealand Preference) 1933-1950 is amended as set out in the Schedule to this Act and duties of Customs are imposed in accordance with the first-mentioned Schedule as amended by the last-mentioned Schedule.

Time of imposition of duties.

3. The time of the imposition of the duties of Customs imposed by this Act is the twenty-seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Australian Capital Territory, and this Act shall be deemed to have come into operation at that time.
