No. 3 of 1935.

An Act to amend section twelve of the *Dried*Fruits Export Control Act 1924-1934.

[Assented to 4th April, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Dried Fruits Export Control Act* 1935.
- (2.) The *Dried Fruits Export Control Act* 1924–1934*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Dried Fruits Export Control Act* 1924–1935.

2. Section twelve of the Dried Fruits Export Control Act 1924- Appointment of officers. 1934 is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection :-

"(4.) Where an officer appointed as Secretary to the Board in pursuance of this section was, immediately prior to his appointment, an officer of the Public Service of the Commonwealth, his service as an officer of the Board shall, for the purpose of determining his existing and accruing rights, be taken into account as if it were service in the Public Service of the Commonwealth, and the Officers' Rights Declaration Act 1928-1933 shall apply as if this Act and section had been specified in the Schedule to that Act.".

CANNED FRUITS EXPORT CONTROL.

An Act to amend the Canned Fruits Export Control Act 1926-1934.

[Assented to 4th April, 1935.]

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Canned Fruits Export Control Short title Act 1935.

- (2.) The Canned Fruits Export Control Act 1926-1934* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Canned Fruits Export Control Act 1926-1935.
- 2. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by inserting Definitions. in the definition of "canned fruits", after the word "prescribed" the words ", and includes canned fruit salad which consists of not less than seventy-five per centum of any one or more of the fruits which are specified in this definition or are prescribed ".

3. Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by adding Appointment of officers. at the end thereof the following sub-section:-

"(4.)
