An Act to amend the Egg Export Charges Act 1947 in relation to Decimal Currency.

 B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Egg Export Charges Act 1965.

Short title and citation.

(2.) The Egg Export Charges Act 1947,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Egg Export Charges Act 1947-1965.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the fourteenth day commenceof February, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.

3. The Schedule to the Egg Export Charges Act 1947 is The Schedule. repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:--
