FINANCIAL RELIEF.

No. 1 of 1936.

An Act relating to Financial Assistance to the States in the provision of Relief to Primary Producers, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 20th March, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Financial Relief Act* 1936.

(2.) The Financial Relief Act 1934-1935* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Financial Relief Act 1934-1936.

2. Section nineteen of the Principal Act is amended -

(a) by omitting the words "the sum of Three hundred and twenty-five thousand pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "such sums as are necessary"; and

(b) by omitting all words after the word "wheat".

3. Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended by Conditions of omitting the words "thirty-first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five " and inserting in their stead the words "thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six ".

4. Section twenty-two of the Principal Act is amended-

- (a) by omitting the words "out of the amount appropriated by this Part" and inserting in their stead the words "out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly"; and
- (b) by omitting the words "thirty-first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five" and inserting in their stead the words "thirtieth day of April, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six".

WHEAT GROWERS RELIEF.

No. 2 of 1936.

An Act to provide for Financial Assistance to the States in the provision of Relief to Wheat Growers.

[Assented to 20th March, 1936.]

B it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Wheat Growers Relief Act 1936.

2. In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—"wheat grower" means any person who has sown wheat for the production of grain during the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

3. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, the sums necessary to provide for the payments authorized to be made under this Act.

4. There shall be granted to the States specified in this section, by way of financial assistance to those States, the amounts respectively specified opposite the names of those States :---

Assistance to wheat growers in Territory for the Seat of Government. 5. There shall be made available a sum not exceeding Three hundred and sixty pounds for distribution, in the manner determined by the Minister, among wheat growers in the Territory for the Seat of Government.
