1. This Act may be cited as the Further Supplementary Appropriation Act 1910-11.

2. The sum of One hundred and fifty-three thousand one hundred and eighty-six pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and eleven shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 1 of 1910 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.
