

GOVERNOR-GENERAL'S ESTABLISHMENT.

No. 7 of 1902.

An Act relating to the Governor-General's Establishment.

[Assented to 30th May, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble.
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in
the House of Representatives, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Governor-General's Establish- Short title.*
ment Act 1902.

2. To assist in defraying the expenses of the Governor-General's Allowance to
establishment in connexion with the visit to Australia of Their Governor-
Royal Highnesses the Duke and Duchess of Cornwall and York General.
there shall be paid to him out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund
an extraordinary allowance of Ten thousand pounds, and the Con-
solidated Revenue Fund is hereby appropriated accordingly for that

COMMONWEALTH FRANCHISE.

No. 8 of 1902.

An Act to provide for an Uniform Federal Franchise.

[Assented to 12th June, 1902.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Commonwealth Franchise Act Short title.*
1902, and shall be incorporated and read as one with the *Common-*
wealth Electoral Act 1902.

2. This Act shall not affect any election of a new member to fill Application of
any vacancy occurring in the House of Representatives during the Act.
