# HIGH COMMISSIONER.

#### No. 52 of 1940.

## An Act to amend section nine of the *High* Commissioner Act 1909-1937.

[Assented to 22nd August, 1940.]

[Date of commencement, 19th September, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the High Commissioner Act short title and citation. 1940.
- (2.) The High Commissioner Act 1909-1937\*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the High Commissioner Act 1909-1940
- 2. Section nine of the High Commissioner Act 1909 1937 is High amended—

Commissioner may appoint officers.

(a) by omitting sub-section (3.); and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (5.) the words ", subject to sub-section (3.) of this section,".

### CUSTOMS TARIFF VALIDATION.

# No. 53 of 1940.

An Act to provide for the Validation of Collections of Duties of Customs under Customs Tariff Proposals.

[Assented to 22nd August, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :--

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff Validation Act Short title.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement, receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. All duties of Customs demanded or collected (whether before Validation of the dissolution or expiry of the present House of Representatives under Customs or at or after that dissolution or expiry and on or before the twentyfirst day of February, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one)
