An Act to amend the Honey Levy Act (No. 2) 1962, as amended by the Honey Levy Act (No. 2) 1965, in relation to Decimal Currency.

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation. 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Honey Levy Act (No. 2A) 1965.

(2.) The Honey Levy Act (No. 2) 1962,* as amended by the Honey Levy Act (No. 2) 1965, \dagger is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) Section 1 of the *Honey Levy Act* (No. 2) 1965 is amended by omitting sub-section (3.).

(4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Honey Levy Act (No. 2) 1962-1965.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the fourteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.

Rate of levy.

3. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words "one-half penny" and inserting in their stead the words "Five-twelfths of a cent"; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "one penny" and inserting in their stead the words "One cent".
