

HIGH COURT PROCEDURE.

No. 63 of 1933.

An Act to amend the *High Court Procedure Act* 1903-1925.

[Assented to 15th December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *High Court Procedure Act* 1933.

(2.) The *High Court Procedure Act* 1903-1925* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *High Court Procedure Act* 1903-1933.

Interest on
judgments.

2. Section twenty-six A of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“26A.—(1.) Every judgment debt, the entry of which is dated as of a date prior to the commencement of this section, shall carry interest at the rate of Seven pounds per centum per annum from the date as of which the judgment is so entered.

(2.) Every judgment debt, the entry of which is dated as of the date of, or as of a date subsequent to, the commencement of this section, shall carry interest at the rate of Five pounds per centum per annum from the date as of which the judgment is so entered.”

INVALID AND OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 64 of 1933.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 15th December, 1933.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Appropriation Act* 1933.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act* 1901–1926, and known as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for invalid and old-age pensions.

JUDICIARY.

No. 65 of 1933.

An Act to amend section four of the *Judiciary Act* 1903–1932.

[Assented to 15th December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Judiciary Act* 1933.

Short title
and citation.

(2.) The *Judiciary Act* 1903–1932,* as amended by the *Seat of Government Supreme Court Act* 1933,† is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Judiciary Act* 1903–1933.

2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word “six” and inserting in its stead the word “five”.
