INVALID AND OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 2 of 1937.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 1st July, 1937.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Appropriation Act 1937.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, Appropriation which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the for Invalid and Trust Account established under the Audit Act 1901–1934, and known Pensions. as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Fifteen million pounds for invalid and old-age pensions.

FEDERAL AID ROADS AND WORKS.

No. 3 of 1937.

An Act to authorize the Execution by the Commonwealth of Agreements between the Commonwealth and the States in relation to the Construction, Re-construction, Maintenance and Repair of Roads and other Works connected with Transport and to make provision for the carrying out thereof.

[Assented to 3rd July, 1937.]

HEREAS it is expedient to provide for financial assistance Preamble. to the several States for the purpose of the construction, re-construction, maintenance and repair of roads and other works connected with transport:

BE it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Federal Aid Roads and Works Short title. Act 1937.
- 2. The execution, by or on behalf of the Commonwealth, of Execution of agreements in the form contained in the Schedule to this Act, between authorized, the Commonwealth and each State of the Commonwealth is hereby authorized.

3.—(1.) For the purposes of this Act there shall be a Trust Account, Appropriation known as the Federal Aid Roads and Works Trust Account, which shall be kept in the books of the Treasury.
