INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION (ADDITIONAL CONTRIBUTION).

No. 66 of 1963.

An Act to approve the payment by Australia of an Additional Contribution to the International Development Association.

[Assented to 30th October, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the International Development short title. Association (Additional Contribution) Act 1963.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which Commence it receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. The approval of the Parliament is hereby given to the payment by Australia to the International Development Association of an additional contribution not exceeding a sum equivalent to Nineteen million eight hundred thousand United States dollars.
- 4. Any payment under the last preceding section shall be made Appropriation. out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is appropriated accordingly.
- 5. Section six of the *International Development Association* Issue of Act 1960 applies to any payment under section three of this Act as it applies to payments under that Act.
