

Interim Forces Benefits Act 1973

No. 5 of 1973

AN ACT

To amend the *Interim Forces Benefits Act 1947-1966*.

[Assented to 16 March 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, the Senate and the House of Representatives of Australia, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Interim Forces Benefits Act 1973*.
(2) The *Interim Forces Benefits Act 1947-1966*,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Interim Forces Benefits Act 1947-1973*.

Commence-
ment.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. After section 7 of the *Interim Forces Benefits Act 1947-1966* the following section is inserted:—

Application
of section
120c of
Repatriation
Act.

“7A. Section 120c of the *Repatriation Act 1920-1973* applies in relation to a pension, allowance or other benefit under this Act or the regulations as if it were a pension, allowance or other benefit under that Act.”
