2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, Appropriation of £10,000,000 which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the for Invalid and Trust Account established under the Audit Act 1901–1926, and known Pengions. as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for invalid and old-age pensions.

## No. 65 of 1933.

## An Act to amend section four of the *ludiciary Act* 1903-1932.

[Assented to 15th December, 1933.]

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Judiciary Act 1933.

Short title

- (2.) The Judiciary Act 1903-1932,\* as amended by the Seat of Government Supreme Court Act 1933,† is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Judiciary Act 1903-1933.
- 2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the Justices. word "six" and inserting in its stead the word "five".
