

and twenty-eight, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Territory for the Seat of Government, there shall be charged, collected and paid to the King for the purposes of the Commonwealth on butter and cheese produced or manufactured in the Dominion of New Zealand and imported direct from that Dominion after the time and date above specified or imported direct from that Dominion before, and entered for home consumption after, that time and date, duty of Customs at the rate of sixpence per pound.

LOAN (No. 1).

No. 26 of 1928.

An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of certain Sums of Money.

[Assented to 22nd June, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Loan Act (No. 1) 1928*.

Short title.

2. The Treasurer may from time to time under the provisions of the *Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1927*, or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Two million pounds.

Authority
to borrow
£2,000,000.

Purpose for which money may be borrowed.

3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the purposes of appropriations made or to be made by law.

Issue and application of £1,920,000.

4. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any Loan raised under the authority of any Loan Act, including the present Act, the sum of One million nine hundred and twenty thousand pounds for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act.

Unexpended appropriations lapse.

5. Where on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight there remain unexpended any moneys appropriated by the *Loan Act (No. 1) 1927* and *Loan Act (No. 2) 1927* the appropriation of the moneys so remaining unexpended shall lapse on that date.
