- 2. Section two of the Amendments Incorporation Act 1905 is amended by inserting, after sub-section (2.), the following subsection:—
- "(2a.) When an Act, which amends a Principal Act in the manner mentioned in sub-section (1.), prescribes a method of citation for the Principal Act as amended by that Act, the Principal Act shall be deemed to be amended by substituting that method of citation for the short title of the Principal Act, and in every reprint of the Act as so amended that method of citation shall be substituted accordingly."

## No. 33 of 1918.

An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of the sum of One million two hundred and fortytwo thousand one hundred and ninety-four pounds for certain purposes.

[Assented to 12th December, 1918.]

B it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan Act 1918.

Treasurer may borrow £1,242,194.

2. The Treasurer may from time to time, under the provisions of the Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1918, or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of One million two hundred and forty-two thousand one hundred and ninety-four pounds.

Purposes for which moneys may be expended. 3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act
