LOAN (HOUSING).

No. 60 of 1961.

An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending of Moneys for the purposes of Housing.

[Assented to 24th October, 1961.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan (Housing) Act 1961.

Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which Commenceit receives the Royal Assent.

3. The Treasurer may, from time to time, in accordance with Authority to the provisions of the Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911- borrow £42,900,000. 1946, or in accordance with the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole Forty-two million nine hundred thousand pounds.

Application of moneys.

4. Moneys borrowed under this Act shall be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the purpose of making advances to States in pursuance of section four or five of the *Housing Agreement Act* 1961.
