3. Section eighty-four of the Principal Act is amended by adding Permanent at the end of sub-section (8.) the following proviso :---

"Provided that if, in addition, the medical practitioner certifies that any physical defect of the returned soldier is likely to prevent continuance of efficient service up to the age of sixty years, the returned soldier shall not, if appointed to the Commonwealth Service, be deemed to be an employee within the meaning, and for the purposes, of the Superannuation Act 1922–1934.".

An Act to Authorize the Raising of a certain Sum of Money and for other purposes.

[Assented to 16th November, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :----

1. This Act may be cited as the Loan Act (No. 2) 1934.

2. The Treasurer may, from time to time, under the provisions of the Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1933, or under the £5,050,000. provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the sum of Five million and fifty thousand pounds.

3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for the Purposes for expenses of borrowing and for the purposes of appropriations made or to be made by law.

4. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any Issue and Loan raised under the authority of any Loan Act, including this Act, application of 2200.000. the sum of Two hundred thousand pounds for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
