Sec. 2. **AMENDMENTS OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE PRINCIPAL ACT.**

EXCISE DUTIES.

Articles.	Rate of Duty.
6. By omitting the whole of sub-item (A) and inserting in its stead the following sub-item :— “ (A)*Tobacco, hand-made strand :— (1) In the manufacture of which all the tobacco leaf used is Australian-grown - - - - - per lb. (2) Otherwise - - - - - per lb. HAND-MADE TOBACCO.—“ Hand-made Tobacco ” shall mean tobacco in the manufacture of which all operations are entirely carried on by hand without the aid of machine tools or machinery other than that used in the pressing of the tobacco.”	4s. 3d. 4s. 11d.
By omitting the whole of sub-item (B) and inserting in its stead the following sub-item :— “ (B) Tobacco, manufactured, n.e.i. :— (1) In the manufacture of which all the tobacco leaf used is Australian-grown - - - - - per lb. (2) Otherwise - - - - - per lb.	4s. 6d. 5s. 2d.”
By omitting the whole of sub-item (D) and inserting in its stead the following sub-item :— “ (D) Tobacco, in the manufacture of which all the tobacco leaf used is Australian-grown, for consumption by Australian aborigines, as prescribed by Departmental By-laws - - - - - per lb.	3s. 10d.”

**An Act to authorize the Raising and Expending
of a certain Sum of Money.**

[Assented to 12th December, 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

| Short title. | 1. This Act may be cited as the <i>Loan Act (No. 2) 1938</i> . |
| Commencement. | 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent. |
| Authority to borrow
£10,200,000. | 3. The Treasurer may, from time to time, under the provisions of the <i>Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1933</i> , or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Ten million two hundred thousand pounds. |
| Purpose for which money may be expended. | 4. The amount borrowed may be issued and applied for the expenses of borrowing and for the purposes set forth in the Schedule to this Act. |
