B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :---

Short title and citation.

Amendment of s. 6.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Maternity Allowance Act 1926.

(2.) The *Maternity Allowance Act* 1912,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Maternity Allowance Act* 1912-1926.

2. Section six of the *Maternity Allowance Act* 1912 is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) the word "Asiatics" and inserting in its stead the word "aliens".
