(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Audit Act 1901-1926.

Salary of Auditor-General.

- 2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "One thousand five hundred" and inserting in their stead the words "One thousand seven hundred and fifty".
- 3. After section five of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Auditor-General to retire at sixty-five. " 5A. The Auditor-General for the Commonwealth shall cease to hold office upon attaining the age of sixty-five years.".

## NORTHERN TERRITORY (ADMINISTRATION).

## No. 19 of 1926.

An Act to amend the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910.

[Assented to 11th June, 1926.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1926.
- (2.) The Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1926.

Definition of Minister.

- 2. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "the Minister".
- Disposal of Crown Lands.
- 3. Section eleven of the Principal Act is repealed.
