## NORTHERN TERRITORY ACCEPTANCE.

No. 13 of 1952.
An Act to amend the Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910-1919, as amended by the Northern Australia Act 1926.
[Assented to 30th May, 1952.]
[Date of commencement, 27th June, 1952.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-
1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Northern Territory Acceptance short title Act 1952 .
(2.) The Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910-1919*, as amended by the Northern Australia Act 1926 $\dagger$, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910-1952.
2. Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after Continuance the word "shall" the words ", subject to Ordinances in force under $\begin{gathered}\text { of end intates } \\ \text { anesta. }\end{gathered}$ the Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1949,".
