

## NORTHERN TERRITORY ACCEPTANCE.

### No. 13 of 1952.

An Act to amend the *Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910-1919*, as amended by the *Northern Australia Act 1926*.

[Assented to 30th May, 1952.]

[Date of commencement, 27th June, 1952.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1952*.

(2.) The *Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910-1919\**, as amended by the *Northern Australia Act 1926†*, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910-1952*.

2. Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "shall" the words "; subject to Ordinances in force under the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910-1949*,".
