OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 18 of 1908.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Seven hundred and fifty thousand pounds for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 10th June, 1908.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble, and the House of Raynasantatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Old-age Pensions Appropriation short title. Act 1908.
- 2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, Appropriation which is hereby appropriated accordingly for the purposes of the Invalid and Trust Account established under the Audit Acts 1901-1906, and Old-age Pensions. known as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Seven hundred and fifty thousand pounds for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

COAST DEFENCE APPROPRIATION.

No. 19 of 1908.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Two hundred and fifty thousand pounds for Harbor and Coastal Defences.

[Assented to 10th June, 1908.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Coast Defence Appropriation short title. Act 1908.
- 2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Appropriation Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly for the purposes of £250,000 for Harbor and of the Trust Account established under the Audit Acts 1901-1906 Coastal Defence. and known as the Harbor and Coastal Defence (Naval) Account, the sum of Two hundred and fifty thousand pounds for Harbor and Coastal Defence (Naval) purposes.
