

OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 22 of 1911.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1911.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Old-age Pensions Appropriation Act* 1911.

Short title.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the Audit Acts 1901-1906, and known as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Four million pounds for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

Appropriation of £4,000,000 for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

TELEGRAPHS AND TELEPHONES SPECIAL WORKS ACCOUNT.

No. 23 of 1911.

An Act to authorize the expending of moneys paid into the Trust Fund Telegraphs and Telephones Special Works Account.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1911.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Telegraphs and Telephones Special Works Account Act* 1911.

Short title.
