Rights of officers previously Government Resident.

- "17B. Any person who held the office of Government Resident under the Act repealed by this Act, and who-
 - (a) held office in that capacity immediately prior to the commencement of this section; and
 - (b) is continued in employment by the Commonwealth or any authority under the Commonwealth,

shall in such employment retain his existing and accruing rights arising out of his service as Government Resident and out of any service under the Commonwealth in which he was engaged immediately prior to his being appointed Government Resident and, for that purpose, his service as Government Resident or otherwise under the Commonwealth shall be included as part of his service in such employment.".

An Act relating to Duties of Excise.

[Assented to 21st November, 1933.]

I E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Excise Tariff 1933.

Short title and citation.

- (2.) The Excise Tariff 1921-1928* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Excise Tariff 1921-1933.
- 2. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended as set out in the Amendment of Tariff. Schedule to this Act, and Duties of Excise are hereby imposed in accordance with the first-mentioned Schedule as amended by the last-mentioned Schedule.

3.—(1.) The time of the imposition of the Duties of Excise Time of imposed by this Act, except in respect of items in the Schedule to imposition of Duties of Excise. this Act in respect of which a later date is specified, is the twentysixth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, at
