POST AND TELEGRAPH RATES.

No. 1 of 1931.

An Act to amend the Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902-1930.

[Assented to 25th March, 1931.]

E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of lustralia, as follows :--

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Rates Short title and citation. 1ct 1931.
- (2.) The Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902-1930* is in this Act eferred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as he Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902-1931.
 - 2. This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by Proclamation. Commencement.

Postage on Second Class Mail Matter.

3. Part II. of the First Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words—

"Second Class Mail Matter (comprising printed papers (including books, periodicals and newspapers not registered at a General Post Office), commercial papers, catalogues, patterns, samples and merchandisc) as prescribed

One penny per two ounces or part of two ounces "

and inserting in their stead the words-

" Second Class Mail Matter-

(a) Commercial papers, patterns, samples and merchandise, as prescribed

(b) Printed matter (including printed papers, circulars and catalogues, and books, periodicals and newspapers not registered at a General Post Office) as prescribed One penny per two ounces or part of two ounces
One penny per four ounces or part of four ounces".

WINE EXPORT BOUNTY.

No. 2 of 1931.

An Act to amend the Wine Export Bounty Act 1930.

[Assented to 25th March, 1931.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title and

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Wine Export Bounty Act 1931.
- (2.) The Wine Export Bounty Act 1930* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Wine Export Bounty Act 1930-1931.

Establishment of Trust Account and payment of bounty therefrom.

- 2. Section four of the Principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by inserting in sub-section (3.), after the word "every", the word "proof"; and
 - (b) by adding at the end of sub-section (3.) the words "together with a sum equal to five-elevenths of the amount paid by way of duty of excise under any Tariff or Tariff proposal on or after the fourth day of December One thousand nine hundred and thirty on concentrated grape must for use in the manufacture of wine".
