

## Pay-roll Tax (Territories) Assessment

No. 66 of 1972

An Act relating to the Exemption from Pay-roll Tax of Wages paid by certain Representatives of Governments of Countries other than Australia.

[Assented to 31 August 1972]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Pay-roll Tax (Territories) Assessment Act 1972*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Pay-roll Tax (Territories) Assessment Act 1971*,\* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Pay-roll Tax (Territories) Assessment Act 1971–72*.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent. Commencement.

3. Section 13 of the *Pay-roll Tax (Territories) Assessment Act 1971* is amended by omitting from sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (f) the words “a consular or other representative (other than a diplomatic representative)” and inserting in their stead the words “a representative (other than a diplomatic or consular representative)”. Exemption from tax.
