An Act to amend the *Representation Act* 1948.

[Assented to 27th October, 1949.] [Date of commencement, 24th November, 1949.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :---

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Representation Act 1949.

(2.) The Representation Act 1948*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Representation Act 1948-1949.

2. Section seven of the Representation Act 1948 is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead :----

"7. The allowance payable under the Parliamentary Allowances Reckoning of Act 1920-1947 to a senator to whom sub-section (3.) or (4.) of section allowances to five of this Act applies shall be reckoned from and including the day certain senators. of his election.".

An Act to amend the Customs Act 1901-1947.

[Assented to 27th October, 1949.]

D E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, D and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :----

1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the Customs Act 1949.

Short title and ditation.

(2.) The Customs Act 1901-1947*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Customs Act 1901-1949.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by commencement. Proclamation.

3.—(1.) After section one hundred and sixty-four of the Customs Act 1901-1947 the following section is inserted :--

"164A. A rebate, as prescribed, may be made of duty payable Bebate of on the importation of leaf tobacco, as an allowance in respect of duty on leaf waste in manufacturing operations.".

(2.) The section inserted in the Customs Act 1901-1947 by this section shall not apply in relation to leaf tobacco entered for home consumption before the commencement of this Act.
