

Referendum (Constitution Alteration)

No. 49 of 1965

An Act to amend section 4 of the *Referendum (Constitution Alteration) Act 1906–1936*.

[Assented to 3 June, 1965]

[Date of Commencement, 1 July, 1965]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Referendum (Constitution Alteration) Act 1965*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Referendum (Constitution Alteration) Act 1906–1936*,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Referendum (Constitution Alteration) Act 1906–1965*.

2. Section 4 of the *Referendum (Constitution Alteration) Act 1906–1936* is amended by inserting in paragraph (f) of sub-section (2.), after the words “one hundred and five A,”, the words “one hundred and five B,”. Application of Electoral Act.
