

or permitted to be prescribed, or which are necessary or convenient to be prescribed, for carrying out or giving effect to this Act, and, in particular—

- (a) after report to the Minister by the Wine Overseas Marketing Board constituted under the *Wine Overseas Marketing Act* 1929, for prescribing lower rates of the charge imposed on grapes intended for use in the manufacture of wine; and
- (b) for prescribing penalties not exceeding Fifty pounds for any breach of the Regulations.

6. This Act shall continue in force until a date to be fixed by Proclamation as the date upon which the Act shall cease to be in force. Duration of Act.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty.

[Assented to 22nd March, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supply Act (No. 1) 1929—30*. Short title.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty the sum of Five million seven hundred and five thousand five hundred and seventy-three pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied. 3. The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor-General in respect of any purposes and services set forth in the said Schedule.
