An Act to amend the Spirits Act 1906–1966 in relation to the use of Methylated Spirits in Scents, and in relation to the establishment of a Collectorate of Customs in the Northern Territory.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Spirits Act 1968.

Short title

- (2.) The Spirits Act 1906-1966* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Spirits Act 1906-1968.
- 2. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition Interpretation. of "Scents".
 - 3. Section 14 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-section (2.) the word their use. "scents,"; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (6.) the word "scents.".
- 4. Section 16 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) the word "scent".

Penalty for selling illicit methylated spirits.

- 5. Section 17 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word Forfeiture of " scents".
- 6. Section 18 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word spirits containing " scents".

7. Section 20 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "State" the words "or Territory of the Commonwealth".

Licences to make and sell methylated spirits.

8. Section 22 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from sub- Power to enter and take section (1.) the word "scent,".

9. Section 23 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word Penalty for " scent,".

10. Section 25 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word Power to seize. " scents,".
